## 2021 Successes



### EDUCATION PROGRAM

- 8 students finished high school
- 6 students graduated from university or a vocational program
- 4 recipients of excellence awards



### MENTAL HEALTH

- 1250 hours of life counseling
- 1000 hours of trauma therapy
- 750 hours of recreation and exercise
- 200 hours of peer mentoring



### YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

- 43 youth received life skills training and tools for independent living
- 35 youth developed life plans and worked through orientation



### TRAININGS

- 28 hours in staff development
- 12 hours leading national trainings for orphanage workers in Perú
- 12 hours developmentors



### OUTREACH DURING COVID-19

- 200 meals to women in rural areas
- 54 youth in the community received financial and medical assistance
- 120 families received emergency kits



### PARTNERSHIPS

- 2 representatives on national committee advocating for the rights of youths
- 13 businesses for youth employment
- 3 mentor families for youth





Thank you for donating, making pledges and praying for our the completion of our building. This facility houses 18 girls who are transitioning out of orphan care. Our staff offices are on the first floor, and there are two meeting spaces to accommodate all of our youth trainings and celebrations. Because of you, the building is paid for and we are debt free!

Heroes of Hope is a monthly giving program that began this year and has 35 members. Their faithfulness is a tremendous blessing. The end of year matching fund campaign resulted in generous contributions that totaled over \$36,000 towards opening the boys' transitional home. The 8th Annual Snowshoe for Perú 5k event raised \$15,500.

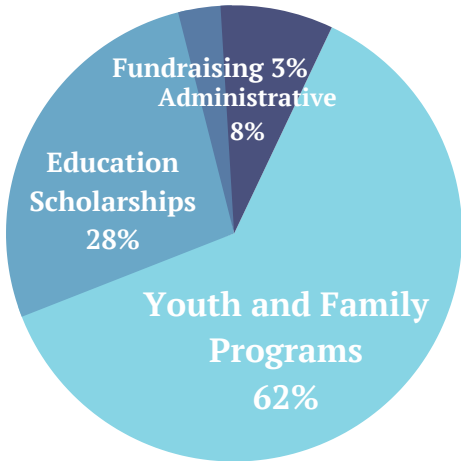
