2022 Successes



EDUCATION PROGRAM

- 23 students were enrolled in high school, vocational school, or university
- 9 students graduated from school
- 2 recipients of excellence awards



MENTAL HEALTH

- 1450 hours of life counseling
- 800 hours of trauma therapy
- 1020 hours of recreation and exercise
- 250 hours of peer mentoring



YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

- 7 youth entered the transitional home
- 4 youth moved into their own housing
- 48 youth received life skills training and tools for independent living



TRAININGS

- 800 youth received our national "Finances for Life" trainings
- 36 hours leading national trainings for orphanage staff and leaders to improve overall care for children



ORPHANAGE OUTREACH

- 43 youth developed life plans and worked through life skills training
- 32 workshops were attended
- 9 orphanages in 3 counties participated



PARTNERSHIPS

- 4 representatives on national committees advocating for the rights of youths
- 14 businesses for youth employment
- 9 national and international networks



Joy of Giving

Thanks to you, the Charles and Carol Miller Family Foundation, the Verrill Family Foundation and the Ayers Foundation we officially opened the boys transitional home. Your generosity allowed us to rent an apartment, fully furnish the apartment, and hire an additional staff member. Now, five boys have safe-housing and hope for the future. Each young man is studying a degree they are passionate about and learning the needed skills to eventually live on their own.



Peru Crew mission trips were hosted again in June and July, bringing encouragement, training, and extra hands to finish ongoing projects. The end of year matching fund campaign resulted in generous contributions that totaled over \$55,000 to continue helping youth. The 10th Annual Snowshoe for Perú raised \$15,500 and the 2nd Annual Power of the Purse event raised \$20,000 to continue providing safety, education and hope to vulnerable youth aging out of the orphan care system.
