2023 Successes



EDUCATION PROGRAM

- 32 students were enrolled in high school, vocational school, or university
- 7 students graduated from school
- 3 recipients of excellence awards



MENTAL HEALTH

- 2,030 hours of life counseling
- 750 hours of trauma therapy
- 1200 hours of recreation and exercise
- 30 hours of interactive workshops



YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

- 9 youth entered the transitional home
- 4 youth moved into their own housing
- 76 youth received life skills training and tools for independent living



PARTNERSHIPS

- Elected by Peruvian government to help lead foster care initiatives
- Rhiza Coffee youth mentorship through employment and training



ORPHANAGE OUTREACH

- 43 youth developed life plans and worked through life skills training
- 26 workshops were attended
- 10 orphanages in 3 counties participated



MENTOR FAMILY PROGRAM

- 8 families recruited and trained
- 10 youth matched with a mentor family
- 2 new churches participating



Joy of Giving

The launch of our Mentor Family Program marks a significant milestone in our mission to support vulnerable youth in our program. By pairing 10 individuals with caring mentor families, we've created a powerful support system that provides guidance, stability, and encouragement. This initiative not only fosters positive relationships but also equips our youth with an invaluable sense of belonging, setting them on a path filled with hope and opportunity.



The Circle of Hope has grown to include 85 members whose faithful monthly donations provide the basic needs of youths in our program. The Power of the Purse event raised \$25,000 to continue The end of year matching fund campaign resulted in generous contributions that totaled over \$49,000 to continue providing safety, education and hope to vulnerable youth aging out of the orphan care system.
